Locke Your Beart on These Pearls



John Locke significantly influenced democratic thought in England. Our Masonic ideals attest to this. Here are a few pearls from reading his collection:

On Knowledge: "It is worthwhile to search out the bounds between opinion and knowledge, and examine by what measures, in things wherefore we have no certain knowledge, we ought to regulate our assent and moderate our persuasion."

On Memory: "Memory... where it is wanting...all the rest of our faculties are in great measure, useless... Our thoughts, reasonings and knowledge, could not proceed ... were it not for the assistance of our memories." "The dull man... while he is seeking in his mind for those ideas that should serve his turn, is not much happier than one who is perfectly ignorant. It is the business therefore of memory to furnish to the mind those dormant ideas which it has present occasion for, for in the having them ready at hand on all occasions, consists that which we call invention, fancy and quickness of parts."

On Reason: "Reason in four degrees. The first and highest is the discovery of truths. Second, the regular disposition of them and laying them in a clear and fit order. The third is to make their connection. And the fourth, making the right conclusion." "Syllogism ... is not the only nor the best way of reasoning... [Men] who are willing to find [truth] and desire to make the best use [of it] may attain it."

On Intuition: "Intuitive knowledge... [is] the highest of all human certainty. In this consists the evidence of maxims which nobody has any doubts about... In the discovery and assent to these truths, there is no use of the discursive faculty, no need of reasoning, but they are known by a superior and higher degree of evidence. And such if I may guess of things unknown, I think that angels have now, and the spirit of just men made perfect shall have, in a future state, of thousands of things which now either wholly escape our apprehensions, on which our short-sighted reason having to get some faint glimpse of, we, in the dark, grope after."

Some left-brained brethren may have trouble with this last paragraph. If this is the case, I recommend you ponder this concept in the EA lecture: "You were hoodwinked... for three reasons: first that your heart might be taught to conceive before your eyes beheld the beauties of Masonry."


