Spring. It is nearly time to consider what garden you intend to plant this year, lay out the plot, and think about ordering or buying the seeds/stock you will need to get things going. Good luck, and if you get too many beautiful tomatoes - share with those who didn't plan ahead!

A call for BILDUNG in our ritual



The book, The School and Society, The Child and the Curriculum by John Dewey was printed in 1899. It has never been out of print because its basic principles still resonate today.

John Dewey was one of the pioneers of American education. He believed that every educational subject was an aspect of a greater whole, an extrasensory entity—the divine will, or the Absolute. At the time, this philosophy was known as BILDUNG, a German concept that education should aim to the apprehension of spiritual oneness. You may suspect Dewey to be an unbalanced religious fanatic. Far from it he was one of the founders of pragmatism, a progressive, liberal philosophy or proposition that something is true if it works satisfactorily. The meaning of a proposition is to be found in the practical consequences of accepting it, and that unpractical ideas are to be rejected.

"Knowledge is inseparably united with doing," Dewey wrote, in opposition to the prevailing "method of education where facts are handed down from teacher to pupil as disembodied information... knowledge is [thus] cut off from the activity in which it has its meaning, and becomes a false abstraction between knowing and doing." Our masonic ritual aims to imprint our minds and hearts with DOING so that we may apply the spiritual lessons inculcated therein in our lives. Dewey reminds us we do well to do so with a BALANCE of conservative and progressive values in a pragmatic way.

Hello Nobles and Ladies,

Salt Lake St. Patrick's Day Parade Information:

Thank you to those who have responded as to your organizations participation in the St. Patrick's Day Parade. I

have heard back from Job's Daughters, Ladies of the Oriental Shrine, Daughters of the Nile, El Kalah Fire Brigade, El Kalah Clowns, El Kalah Mini Bikes and our Past Potentates. It looks like it will be a great parade with nearly everyone participating!

We have a need for a driver of the Yellowstone Bus, if you are interested please reach out to me.

The parade will be on Saturday March 11th, Step-off is at 11:00am. The staging areas and parade route are the same as last year:

Staging will be along 600 West, 100 South and West Danes Drive, we will not know our staging location until we have out Entry Number, the parade application has been submitted and that information will be sent out as soon as it is available.

The Parade will proceed out of the staging area from 600 West onto 200 South and then onto Rio Grande St, through the Gateway Mall and end at 50 North.

I have already requested that the entire Masonic Family is placed together as a single entry and have received conformation that we will all be together this year as a single Masonic Family Unit. I do not anticipate receiving our entry number until Thursday Evening March 9th, which was the same time it was published last year, at which time I will decimate the information as promptly as possible to all Heads of Organizations. 
